He is also a former Olympic coach for his home country and captained Israel's Junior Davis Cup and Fed Cup teams while acting as the director of the Israeli National Tennis Centre.

A coaching development consultant for Tennis Canada, **Larry** is the leader of the Coach 3 Certification Course and has led several TPA workshops throughout the country. He is an integral part of the Tennis Development Centre program and travels to a number of Canada's TDCs to work with coaches and players.
