PURPOSE OF THE COURSE FACILITATOR SYSTEM

The intent of the Course Facilitator System is to ensure that the content of each level of certification is being delivered in a uniform and professional manner throughout the country.

In order to ensure the standardization of the certification program throughout Canada, Tennis Canada has initiated the following safeguards.

- 1. A standard Course Facilitator Manual for each level of certification.
- 2. The training of Head Course Facilitators from each province, who in turn train the Course Facilitators, Assistant Course Facilitators and Apprentice Course Facilitators within their province.

SYSTEM OVERVIEW

The National Course Facilitator System is an essential part of the development of tennis coaches in Canada

Course Facilitators are the Instructors/Pros/Coaches' "coaching leaders" in the sense that they convey the responsibility for training coaches to effectively and efficiently present the sport of tennis to players across Canada.

The following diagram indicates the structure for the Course Facilitator System and the accompanying charts will help create an understanding of how the system works including roles and responsibilities at each level.
