

## Setting Tournament Types

Open: Tennis Tournament Planner

Go to: 1) Tournament Properties  
2) Then Info Tab  
3) Then Tournament Type

**It has become very important that:**

- a) You set the tournament type properly
- b) You instruct anyone using a TP license in your province to set the field properly.

Here are the settings:

**National:** Don't use it. It is for national events.  
**Provincial:** Use it for all PTA Sanctioned events.  
**Regional:** This is mostly for Quebec's regional events.  
**Community:** For non-sanctioned Community events  
**Club:** For non Sanctioned Club Events  
**Recreational:** For non-sanctioned Recreational events

Why does it matter?

Because: PTA members are allowed to play in an unlimited number of events at any level.  
Because: Recreational Members are allowed to play in as many events as they want - but not at the regional or above level.

So, if you, for example, were to set an event as a Community level event, anyone could enter it by grabbing a free recreational membership.

Also, if clubs start running lots of club tournaments with VR, we do not want them cluttering up the Tennis Canada site - which will be set to filter only to tournaments Regional and above, by default.
