
## **Publishing Messages on the Event Website**

In Tournament Planner when you publish there is an area called "Message". It lets you put a message on the front page of your tournament on line. It is really useful for putting important things like: "Extra! Extra! Showcase match at 1:00 Saturday!" It is limited to 1,000 characters.

**To get to this area:** Under the tournament tab click "Publish this tournament on the web" then you will see the box below.



Until now it was devoid of any formatting. So no matter what you put in the message, it all got stuck together in one long line. And it was hard to see when one note ended and the next began.

This has changed slightly for the better.

If you want a line break you can use the HTML <br> tag in the text to create a new line. If you want to make something stand out, you can use the <b> tag, for bold. So a message might look like this:
